From Boston: Take Route 93 South -Take Exit 7 onto Route 3 South -Take Exit 14 onto Route 228 North -Follow 9 ½ miles crossing Route 53 and Route 3A -Ocean will be on your right, go through two sets of traffic lights and eight buildings on your left is the Hotel -Look for Nantasket Beach Hotel sign on left

From I-95 North, New York, Connecticut: -Follow I-95 North -Take I-93 North -Merge right into Route 3 South -Take exit 14 Route 228 North -Follow 9 ½ miles crossing Route 53 and Rout 3A -Ocean will be on your right, go through two sets of traffic lights and eight buildings on your left is the Hotel -Look for Nantasket Beach Resort sign on left

From I-90 Mass Pike: -Follow I-90 East -Take Exit 14 onto Route 128 South -Merge onto I-93 North -Take exit 7 onto Route 3 South -Take exit 14 Route 228 North -Follow Route 228 North 9 ½ miles crossing Route 53 and Route 3A -Ocean will be on your right, go through two sets of traffic lights and eight buildings on your left is the Hotel -Look for Clarion sign on left

From Cape Cod: -Follow Route 3 North -Take Exit 14 Route 228 North -Follow 228 North for 9 ½ miles crossing Route 53 and Route 3A -Ocean will be on your right, go through two sets of traffic lights and eight buildings on your left is the Hotel -Look for Nantasket Beach Resort sign on the left
